Bible Memory Verse

"God sent his Son." Galatians 4:4

Your Devo Time

As a Family

Memorize Galatians 4:4 together.

Talk this through.

- Who do you think Jesus is?
- Why do you think it was important that God sent His Son?

In Luke 2:22-38 we read about Joseph and Mary presenting baby Jesus at the temple. Simeon declared that Jesus was the long-awaited Messiah. The prophetess Anna thanked God for sending Jesus. Luke 2:8-18 shares about an angel showing up to tell shepherds about Jesus. While the shepherds might have been scared when the angel first appeared, all this happened to share the Good News. Do you know what and who the Good News is?

Christmas is a season of celebration about the promise of Jesus as the Savior of our world. And it's about sharing Him with our friends and family. The wise men and the shepherds were excited to share this news. So think of ways to share about the birth of Jesus with your family and friends.

- As we approach Christmas what are some you are going to share who Jesus is with your friends?
- How are you going to share who Jesus is with your family?

Pray together.

Pray together as a family about who Jesus is. Ask God to help you share who Jesus is with each other this week.

Bible Memory Verse

"[Jesus] grew and became strong." Luke 2:40

Your Devo Time

As a Family

Memorize Luke 2:40 together.

Talk this through.

- What things do you think Jesus did when He was a little kid?

In Luke 2:40, 51 and Matthew 13:55-56 we get a glimpse that Jesus was a lot like you and me. He grew and became strong. Jesus had family with brothers and sisters.

Let's look at this together. Jesus was born to earthly parents to watch over Him and keep Him safe. Just like you and me, Jesus had to grow up, learn to crawl and walk and talk, and lots more. Mary and Joseph did things to keep Jesus safe, just like your mom or dad does for you. When we read Luke 2:42-51, we see that even at 12 years old, Jesus was at the temple listening and asking questions. He learned as much as He could. As you go through this week, spend time with your family talking about:

- Ways God is helping you grow and learn.
- Thanking God for the parents and other adults in your life who protect you and help keep you safe.

Pray together.

Pray together as a family about ways that each person in your family helps to take care of each other. Thank God for those opportunities to grow and learn together.

Unit 6

Jesus Did Good Things

Bible Memory Verse

"[Jesus] went around doing good." Acts 10:38

Your Devo Time

As a Family

Memorize Acts 10:38 together.

Talk this through.

- What type of things do you think Jesus did when He was grown up?

There are a lot of things that Jesus did and taught people as He was growing up. We know that Jesus heals, He loves, He forgives, and He serves others. In Mark 10:35-45, Jesus teaches us about serving others. John and James both wanted to be important. But Jesus told them in verses 43-44, "Whoever wants to become great among you must be your servant, and whoever want to be first must by slave of all." Jesus did this for you and for me.

So one way we can be like Jesus is to look for ways to help and serve others. We all can serve others: take the trash out, take cookies to a neighbor, thank Mom for dinner, text or email someone who is sad, etc.

- What is a way you can help someone in your family this week?
- How do you feel about helping others and having others help you?
- What are some other ways you can serve people?

Pray together.

Pray together as a family about doing things for others. Ask Jesus to help you notice all the ways your friends and family help you.
